17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.

18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.

19. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

20. No animal except the dogs entered for the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance.

21. Should the appointed judge(s) be prevented from fulfilling the appointment, the Committee reserve to themselves the right to appoint another to fulfill the duty. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw their dogs from competition, but no entry fees can be returned.

22. The Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to a dog or property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, nor from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

23. An exercise area will be provided at the Show and exhibitors and handlers are required by Kennel Club Regulations to clear up any fouling made by the dog(s) in their charge.

24. All Bank Charges incurred by the Club through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques in respect of their entries will be passed on to the exhibitor concerned. Failure to pay entry fees and/or Bank Charges will result in the exhibitor being dealt with by the Kennel Club Committee.
