Directions to venue

Leave the M6 at junction 43 taking the exit marked "A69 Carlisle"

Take the left hand lane on the A69 for "Rosehill Ind Est"

At the first set of traffic lights turn left at Land Rover garage onto
Rosehill Industrial Estate

The venue is 200 yards on the left with parking at the rear.

17. All dogs resident outside the U.K. must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

18. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
o When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
o If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
o The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

19. Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entryform and must be Kennel Club Registered.

20. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

21. No animal except the dogs entered for the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance.

22. Should the appointed judge(s) be prevented from fulfilling the appointment, the Committee reserve to themselves the right to appoint another to fulfill the duty. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw their dogs from competition, but no entry fees can be returned.

23. The Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to a dog or property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, nor from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

24. An exercise area will be provided at the Show and exhibitors and handlers are required by Kennel Club Regulations to clear up any fouling made by the dog(s) in their charge.

25. All Bank Charges incurred by the Club through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques in respect of their entries will be passed on to the exhibitor concerned. Failure to pay entry fees and/or Bank Charges will result in the exhibitor being dealt with by the Kennel Club Committee.
