I am Satu Huolman, a Finnish cairn terrier breeder and a judge. I bought my first Cairn terrier in 1980. I did not know much about dog shows at that time. However, my first cairn - FI CH Red-house Royal Prince, "Joonas"- happened to be a good one and I gradually became more and more involved in dog shows and related activities. Joonas became the Cairn of the Year in Finland in 1983. My second dog also became a Finnish champion. Even though I had only males at first Joonas got a bitch puppy in 1990 which I bought and started breeding with her in 1992 under the kennel name "No Copyright". Since then I have had 48 litters and a number of Finnish and International Champions. Also in Europe we have several champions and one U.S. Grand Champion. In 2015, we had the Cairn of the Year and the Best Bitch of the Year in Finland and No Copyright was also rewarded as the Best Cairn Terrier Breeder in Finland that year. I am also very proud that we have had four Best in Shows in Finland, including Best in Show Breeder group. I became a dog show judge in 1993. I can judge Cairns and many other terrier breeds at CC level. I have judged Cairn Terriers all over the world: at Cairn Specialties in many countries, also twice at the World Terrier show. The countries where I have judged include the USA, Australia, Canada, The UK, Russia, Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, Denmark, Sweden, Norway and Finland. I had the honour to be the judge for cairn terriers at the Montgomery show in the USA in 2013. I'm very delighted and honoured to be able to judge at your show in April 2018 and very much look forward to it. In a Cairn, movements and lovely typey heads are very important to me. I love natural looking, well-constructed cairns.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
2. a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present at any time during the Show.
 - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the K.C. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
