Mrs Olive Taylor (Taylorian)

I began exhibiting Yorkshire Terriers in 1979. I have made up 15 Irish Champions (13 homebred) and have 4 dogs in the Stud Book. Whilst accompanying me at dog shows my son Paul fell in love with Chow Chows. When he was 7 years old he came to me at a show and said 'I have seen the most amazing dog. It looks like a Lion and has a purple tongue. I really want to get one mum please.' After reading about the breed and visiting some people who owned Chow Chows, we purchased our first red dog in 1994. He went on to become Ir.Ch.Int.Ch.Lechan Red Warlord.

We all fell in love with the breed and bought a black dog the following year called Lechan Louisiana Flash. Since then I have made up a total of 12 Irish Champions (2 homebred) and have 6 dogs in the Stud Book. Four of my Irish Champions are also GB Champions. Ir & GB Ch. Hiswin Captivating Star who also won Chow of the Year 2011, his son Ir & GB Ch Cladev's Starstruck With Taylorian, his daughter Ir & GB Ch Taylorian Starlight and my import from Belarus Ir & GB Ch Chivas Royal Djalo at Taylorian.

I was a member of the committee of The Ulster Chow Chow Club from 1996 and was Chairperson for several years until its demise in 2013.

I have stewarded on 15 occasions in a 3 year period and have attended many seminars given by accredited KC Trainers. I passed the Chow Judges Training Scheme (15.06.08).

I attended a Chow Chow breed seminar held by Ulster Chow Chow Club for which I provided the dogs for Sheila Jackman. I also attended a seminar of Dog Judging and Critique writing given by Andrew Brace (24.03.12). I have done hands on assessments with Stef Godber (18.08.08). Terry Griffin (30.09.08) and David Robbins (24.02.08).

I award Green Stars in Ireland and all Toy, Utility and Terrier breeds and have awarded Green Stars in Chow Chows on several occasions. I have also judged in Russia on 2 occasions, awarding CACIB's. I also award CC's in Yorkshire Terriers.

I am delighted to be invited by The Chow Chow Club of Scotland to judge their 2017 Championship Show. I have many happy memories at this show, especially winning Chow of the Year in 2011 and Best in Show 2014, 2015, and 2016.

BRONZE HEALTH ASSESSMENT

With the Chow Chow being on the Kennel Club High Profile list, the Breed Council are asking as many chowists as possible to have their dogs health checked in accordance with the proper Health Assessment Form. To this end, this Health Test will be carried out at our Show at a charge of only £15 per dog by a certified vet.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW AND DO

Your dog must be at least 15 months of age.

1. Obtain a Health Check form (free of charge) from Pauline Lock on 01666 510859 (email paulinelen@pau-lin.freemove.co.uk) and bring it with you to the show.
2. Inform Pauline of your dogs Kennel Club Name.
3. Inform Pauline of your dogs microchip number.
4. Inform Pauline of your dogs Kennel Club Reg No.
5. Pay fee AT THE SHOW. Therefore if you cannot get, you will still have the form which you can use at any show carrying out the Check.

This may mean very little to yourself, but is exceptionally important in order for us to prove to the Kennel Club that we are doing our utmost.
