## JUDGES PROFILE

We first started showing Cocker Spaniels in 1977 and were fortunate to make up our first Champion in the Breed in 1982 (Sh Ch Astrawin Avocet of Cabourne). I had my first judging appointment in 1983.

After a long absence from the ring due to family commitments we started showing again in 2007 with a foundation/show bitch from the Lujesa kennels. Poppy (Lujesa Speciosa) acquitted herself well in the ring with 3 RCCs and multiple Best in Show wins.

Her first litter to Sh Ch Asquanne's Gillespie produced two Junior Warrant winners for us, with Ellie, Sh Ch Coedcernyw Cameo going on to become our first homebred Show Champion.

Ellie was mated to Sh Ch Canyonn Classic Illusion and a bitch was retained from that litter. Cara, Sh Ch Coedcernyw Charisma J.W. has 3 CC's and 8 RCC's.

We have always involved ourselves in all aspects of showing and have served on several Committees. I am currently Secretary of South Wales & Mon. Cocker Spaniel Club.

We have a lifelong love of, and interest in, Cocker Spaniels and I am really looking forward to my Breed Club appointment at East of Scotland Cocker Spaniel Club.
