Cheryl Blackley (Wightroche)

As child I was very fortunate to live on the gorgeous Isle of Wight, where animals played a very big part in my life. My Grandma was very involved in breeding and exhibiting papillons and as a small child I took a keen interest in her dogs, it wasn't until later in life that I was able to own my own dogs. I count myself very lucky to have met Jean and John Gilliespie and of course Louise Wilding who pointed me in the right direction when choosing a potential show cocker spaniel. Lochranza Red Gauntlets, aka Rocky (now 12 years old) came to live with us. Rocky won numerous awards, including RCC, 1st at Crufts, he taught me so much about the word of showing and with the support and guidance of Lochranza, my knowledge grew and so did my interest in Cocker Spaniels.

As a small kennel where dogs are very much part of our family I have only bred when we can keep a puppy, those that have gone onto been shown have secured their stud book numbers.
