I got my first cocker spaniel in 1993 and started showing in 1997. I have shown both solid and parti-coloured cockers, undertaking my first judging appointment in 2004.

Despite moving away to university and then raising my young family I have continued to breed and exhibit on a very small scale. I imported Westerner True Lies (imp Swe), an orange and white dog from Sweden with whom I won my first stud book number.

In 2013 I bred Lourisma Shabby Chic JW who was my first Junior Warrant winner. She went on to win my first CC with BoB before being retired for maternal duties. More recently I have had success with my blue roan bitch puppy Lourisma Carousel who won Best Puppy in Show at her first Championship Show.

I have undergone several judging appointments before moving onto B list and I am really looking forward to my Breed Club appointment at East of Scotland Cocker Spaniel Club.

Puppy Walk
