RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show will open at 9.00 a.m.
 2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
 3. Judging will commence at 9.30am
 4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
 5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
 6. ENTRY FEES: £3.50 For EACH DOG; SUBSEQUENT ENTRIES With Same Dog & Junior & Senior Handling - £1.00; Membership Fees: £1.00 Single or Joint.
- CATALOGUES: £3.00 Prepaid (£3.50 on the day)
7. PRIZE MONEY: There is Prize money for stakes classes 146, 147 - 1st £50.00; 2nd £25.00; 3rd £10.00; 4th £5.00
 8. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
 9. Puppies, under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
 10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
 11. There is NO BEST PUPPY IN SHOW AWARD at this Show. SPECIAL BEST PUPPY will be selected only from those exhibits declared Special Best Puppy in each of the seven groups.
 12. BEST IN SHOW: From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information) The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
- BEST OF BREED: Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but from only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
- BEST OF GROUP: Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each Group provided they are unbeaten winning dogs. (b) The best unbeaten winning dog from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group or on each day.
- BEST IN SHOW: From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information) Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection for Best in Show. WITHDRAWAL FROM OTHER COMPETITION: Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition prior to the competition for Best of Group and Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
- PROVISO: For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
 14. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
 15. It is not acceptable to handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. Exhibitors should note that such practices could constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
 16. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
 17. All dogs resident outside the U.K. must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
 18. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events. o When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams. o If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all. o The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog. When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle. Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated. Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
 19. Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club Registered.
 20. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.
 21. The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. All dogs must be registered or transferred in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
 22. No dog other than one duly entered in the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show.
 23. Exhibitors passes and ring numbers will NOT be sent. Entries will only be acknowledged if a stamped addressed postcard is enclosed for the Secretary's signature. Exhibitors Passes will be available at the Show entrance on the day of the Show.
 24. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling their appointment, the Committee may appoint a substitute.
 25. An announcement in 'Dog World' or 'Our dogs' of any alteration made to the schedule will be published as soon as practicable and will be deemed to be sufficient notice thereof.
 26. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to a dog or dogs, or any property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever nor from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
 27. An exercise area will be provided at the Show and exhibitors and handlers are requested to clear up any fouling made by the dog(s) in their charge. Special bins will be provided.
 28. The Committee can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
 29. If in the opinion of the Secretary, Show Manager or any Judge, any dog is considered not in a fit state owing to disease, savage disposition or any other cause, the dog may be excluded or removed from the Show on the instruction of the Show Management.
