

Directions to the Venue:

The small village of Tarbrax is situated just off the A70 and is easily identified by its large red sale bing, a reminder of the village's mining history. Tarbrax is 7 miles from Carnwarth, 12 miles from Livingston and only a short journey from Lanark or Edinburgh.

From the North via M90; M90 follow signs to Edinburgh. At Junction1 exit toward Newbridge Roundabout. At Newbridge Roundabout take 3rd exit onto Newbridge Road/B7030(1min). Turn left onto Cliftonhall Road/B7031(5min). Turn right into A71 (3min). Slight left onto B7031. Take first left to stay on B7031(1min). Turn left onto Station Road/B7031. Continue to follow B7031 (4mins). Turn right onto A70(12 mins). Turn Right toward Tarbrax Road (3mins) Turn right onto Tarbarx Road.

From Glasgow M8 towards Edinburgh/Stirling/M80/Carlisle/M74

At Junction 4 take A801 exit to Bathgate/Whitburn/Falkirk

At the roundabout take 3rd exit onto A801 heading to Whitburn/Blackburn/A705/Seafield/W Calder/B792 (1min) Turn left onto Main Street A705 (2mins) Turn right onto B792 (3mins). Turn Right onto Livingston Street (1min). Continue onto Church Street. Turn left onto Meadowhead Road (1min) Turn right onto A71 (1min). Take first left toward A704 (1min) turn right onto A704 (1 min). Take first left (2min). Turn right (6min). Turn left toward Tarbrax Road (3 min) Turn left onto Tarbrax Road (1 min).

From South West A70/A79

Follow signs for A70 to Hyndford Road/A73. Turn right onto A70. Turn right onto Lanark Road/A70 continue to follow A70 (5mins). Turn left onto Edinburgh Road/A70 continue to follow A70 (9 mins). Turn left toward Tarbrax Road (2min). Turn Right onto Tarbrax Road (2min).
