Meet your Judges

Judith Bradbury (Petalam). The Westie has been my leading light for nearly 60 years, the latter years spent studying the breed, together with a little practical assistance from Mother Nature occasionally so as to have something better to Show. It is this I am still working on. Meanwhile I sincerely endeavour to improve the WHWT breed each time during any future aspects of my breeding, showing and judging the Westie.

Jackie Boyd-McNeil (Glennlokhen) I have been involved in the dog show world vor 36 years, campaigning several breeds to top honours. For the last 15 years I have been showing Irish Setters, my very first bitch, Glencarron Dailuane, was the winnder of 3 RCC's and made up my first Show Champion Glenncarron Shakatak in 2011, who was the winnder of several BIS, RBIS, BVIS at Club Championship and Open Show level and the RCC at Crufts in 2012. I also own several other stud book number winners. I have been judging breeds in the Gundog Group now for over 6 years, I am currently on the B list for Irish Setters and the C list for Flatcoated Retrievers and have completed several other seminars for several other Gundog Breeds, I would like to thank the Officers and Committee for their kind invitation to judge at this lovely show.

Miss Tricia Grim (Ansona) I have been judging gundogs since 1989 and I now passed to award CC's in Weimaraners, Brittany's, GSP's and GWP's/. I have been very fortunate to have owned and bred some lovely dogs, many going onto become champions, I also have a keen interest in working my dogs throughout the season and attending a few working tests. This is my first breed appointment for the Bracco and I am looking forward to my judging.

Mr Tom Johnston (Feldkirk) Owned bred Champions in Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Flatcoats and Hungarian Vizsla's. Award CC's in 60 breeds, approved to judge the Terrier, Working, Hound & Utility Groups. Have judged in Europe, Africa, Australia, New Zealand and Dubai.

Mr Frank H Whyte (Kazval) Owned and bred Champions in Cocker Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Hungarian Vizsla's, Flat Coated Retrievers, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Tibetan Terriers. Been Top Breeder in two breeds and bred a Breed Record holder. Judged in many countries in Europe, South Africa, Dubai, Australia and New Zealand.

John Newsham (Brazenhill) Owned Golden Retrievers for 40 years and Clumber Spaniels for 17 years with my wife Margaret and show Clumber Spaniels regularly at Championship and Open Show. Judged all the gundog breeds at Open show lever over pas 10 years, A1 list judge for Clumber Spaniels and C list for 6 other Gundog breeds. Treasurer and Committee member for 2 breed clubs and 2 canine societies and Dog Show secretary for Staffordshire & Birmingham Agricultural Society.

Mr James Taylor (Delsaux) I have been involved in working gundogs all my life and became involved in Clumbers 10 years ago. This is my second judging appointment in the breed. I began judging at match nights in 2015.

Joe Chorley (Lochrey) Been judging for 40 years. Award CC's in Rough Collies, Border Collies, Award Green Stars in Southern Ireland. Have judged BIS at Open and Premier Shows. On Lancashire Heeler B List.

Mr Gordon Haran (Magregor) As a school boy I attended my first show in 1979. I enjoy showing and judging and the Admin side of our hobby. First judging in 1984, award CC's in 30 breeds, plus several more pending. Have judged at Crufts 3 times and in 11 countries overseas. Made up 21 champions. Look forward to judging at Tonge.

Ms M Waddell (Magregor) Got my first dog in 1974. I enjoy all facets of our hobby, judging commenced in 1989 and award CC's in 9 breeds and the Group.

Mrs Sandra Lane (Kulawand) I, with my husband Bob Lane, started showing in 1973. We have shown Labradors, several Champion Golden Retrievers, and Champion Flatcoated Retriever. I award CC's in Golden and Flatcoated Retrievers. In 1979 we bought out first boarding kennels and I became a professional groomer, trimming all breeds of dogs but mostly terriers and poodles. Therefore in 2000 we started our terrier showing with Norfolk Terriers, and although the top Norfolk Terrier, American Ch & GB Ch Jaeva Dutch Gold still had the affix of Jaeva, he was born at our home out of our bitch Jaeva Dutch Lace (on breeding terms) by the top winning Norfolk Ch Richell Claret who was our choice of stud dog. Our current terriers ar JRT's. I am founder member of the new JRT breed club and attend The National Terrier Championship Show in 2016 when JRT's were first shown in the UK. We have since won several Best Puppies, Best of Breeds at Open Shows and also Best Puppy at Championship Show lever with our JRT's.

Mr Craig Hall (Spingun) Have been involved with Italian Spinone for ten years. I work and show the breed and am enthusiastic to move the breed forward as a dual purpose gundog.
