

Introducing our Dog Judge: Ms Lisa Weiss (Lobuff)(U.S.A.)

As this is Lisa's first U.K. judging appointment we felt it important to provide you with some background information.

Ms Lisa Weiss (Lobuff)(U.S.A.): has judged large entries of Labradors at most of the prestigious Labrador Specialities in America since the 1980's as well as judging at Championship Shows in Canada, Finland and Australia.

Apart from judging Labradors Lisa is licensed to judge Golden Retrievers, English Springer Spaniels, English Cocker Spaniels, English Pointers and Flatcoated Retrievers, and is applying for the license to judge Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, Chesapeake Bay Retrievers, Irish Setters, English Setters, Newfoundlands and Welsh Corgis (Pembroke).

Introducing our Bitch Judge: Mr D Craig (Davricard)

I can never remember a time when my family did not have a dog. The first dog of my own was purchased in 1979 from a local breeder who encouraged me to show her. This was the late Mr Stan Crane (Etherwood) and the bitch was sired by Sh Ch Poolstead Problem. Becoming enthused by the dog show world and realising that my pet was exactly that, I wanted something better with which to begin showing and breeding seriously.

At this time, a black dog was making a huge impact in the show ring- this was Anne Taylor's beautiful Ch Fabracken Comedy Star who I admired so much. It was Anne's mother, Pat, who suggested to my father that we approach Arthur and Peggy Kelley(Bradking) whose good chocolate bitch Bradking Cassandra (Litter sister to Sh Ch Bradking Cassidy) had just whelped a litter to "Murphy".

It was from this litter, born in 1981, that Bradking Birdgette of Davricard came, later to become my first show champion in 1984 after winning her first three CC's under such notable breeder/exhibitors as the late Gwen Broadley (Sandilands) Margot Wooley (Follytower) and Joan Macan (Timspring). She was the granddam of the black dog, Sh Ch Davricard Bobby Shafto.

A close friendship developed with Mr and Mrs Kelley (who, in hindsight, taught me such a great deal about the breed) and they later gave me the black bitch Sh Ch Braking Molly-Mo whose best win was the CC at Cruft's in 1990. With Mr and Mrs Kelley I have the pleasure of campaigning Sh Ch Bradking Hugo to the Breed CC record - in total he won 50 CC's, two of which were at Crufts as well as being a gundog group winner and winning 21 CC's in one year. He was retired gracefully at just over five years of age.

Since this time, I have shown Labradors in Partnership with Angela Williams (Foulby) and have made up five black bitch champions with Sh Ch Foulby Agatha Christie also being a gundog group winner. The latest title holder is Sh Ch Foulby Buttons and Bows who achieved her title in 2008 and whose offspring we are looking forward to campaigning this year.

With Angela I have also co-bred and owned champions in Irish Water Spaniels and Weimaraners as well as owning a reserve CC winning GSP. I also breed Beagles (in which I also award CC's) and have bred one champion, Ch Davricard Dulcie.

I first awarded CC's in Labradors in 1992 and have judged the breed in most European and Scandinavian countries, USA and Australia. The Labrador Club Of Scotland's shows are always well run, enjoyable occasions and I have many happy memories of exciting wins at their shows. This year, I am delighted to be judging the bitch entry at the clubs championship show and am looking forward to the event greatly.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. SATURDAY, 20th February, 2010. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

(1) WITHDRAWAL: The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

(2) TRANSFER: a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

(b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

(d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR: For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING: For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

MAIDEN: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or a First Prize at an Open or Championship Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy Classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

NOVICE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

UNDERGRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.

POST GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.

LIMIT: For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of Any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit and Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN: For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN: For dogs of seven years of age and over on the first day of the Show.

FIELD TRIAL: For dogs which have won An Award, Diplomas of Merit or Certificates of Merit in actual competition at a Field Trial held under Kennel Club or Irish Kennel Club Field Trial Regulations.

BRACE: For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace.

NOT BRED BY EXHIBITOR: For all dogs of the breed which have not been bred by the exhibitor.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: For all dogs of the breed which have been bred by the exhibitor.

BREEDERS: For dogs bred by the exhibitor.
